Medication Assistance Programs

To be eligible for the Portsmouth-Area Medication Assistance Program, individuals:

- Must be uninsured or underinsured
- Must meet income guidelines based on family size (i.e., less than \$19,000 for a single person)

Short-Term Medication Assistance

If you are having trouble paying for your short-term prescriptions, you may be eligible for financial assistance through Community Services' Short-Term Program, funded by the Foundation for Seacoast Health.

- Must be a resident of Eliot, York, Kittery, Greenland, New Castle, Newington, Portsmouth, Rye or North Hampton.
- A medication voucher will be provided for prescription, redeemable at Rite Aid pharmacy on Islington Street in Portsmouth.
- Voucher limit: \$400 per individual, per year. (May change depending on availability of funds.)
- When refills are necessary, please contact Community Services several weeks in advance to avoid interruption in your medication therapy.

Long-Term Medication Assistance

If you are having trouble paying for your long-term prescriptions, you may be eligible for medication assistance through the pharmaceutical companies' prescription programs.

- Must be taking a long-term medication prescribed by a physician/specialist within the Greater Portsmouth area.
- Patients pay a very small fee per prescription.
