2020 *Artists of the Seacoast* Calendar



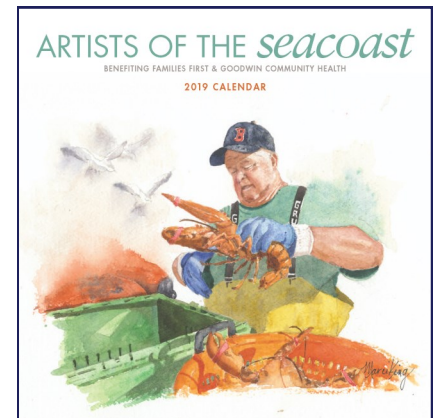
It is our pleasure to invite local artists to submit original works to be considered for inclusion in the 25th annual *Artists of the Seacoast* calendar, which raises funds for Families First Health & Support Center and Goodwin Community Health.

Proceeds from calendar sales, donations, and sponsorships help us provide affordable primary, prenatal and dental care; counseling; substance misuse treatment; family support and parent education; and mobile health care for people experiencing homelessness.

How To Submit Your Artwork

Email a digital photo of your work to Elizabeth Clemence at eclemence@goodwinch.org no later than **Friday, April 12, 2019**.

Please include: your name, phone number, address, title of artwork, and medium. Digital photo submissions do not have to be professional quality but should be good quality (scanned image, smartphone photo, etc.).

Rules & Guidelines

- Artists must live in the Seacoast region (New Hampshire and southern Maine).
- Submit up to three pieces for consideration.
- Works must be original, two-dimensional and cannot be photographs or computer graphics.
- Artwork of square-ish proportions work best for the calendar format.

If Your Artwork Is Chosen

- You will be notified by April 29, 2019
- Once notified, you must provide us with a professional quality image of your work. You may:
 - ⇒ Deliver an image of a minimum of 800 dpi quality to Families First,
 - OR
 - ⇒ Deliver the original artwork to Image Arts in Portsmouth, where it will be professionally scanned during a 3-week period beginning April 29. You will be notified when you may pick up your piece. We will cover the cost of the scan.
- Works chosen for the calendar may also be used for agency notecards and publicity purposes.
