

# New Hampshire Breast and Cervical Cancer Program

Age	Eligible For The Following Screenings:	
21-29	Clinical Breast Exam (CBE), Pelvic Exam, Pap. Mammogram if symptoms or abnormal CBE.	
30-39	CBE, Pelvic Exam, Pap, HPV Test. Mammogram if symptoms or abnormal CBE.	
40-49	CBE, Pap, HPV Test, Pelvic Exam. Should discuss with health care provider about when to start Mammography screening.	
50-64	CBE, Pap, HPV Test, Pelvic Exam, Mammogram.	
65+	Cervical cancer screenings are not recommended for individuals 65 years and older who have had adequate screening and are NOT high risk.  Mammograms until age 75 if NOT eligible for Medicare or not enrolled in Medicare Part B.
